## 1 浅草寺 Sensoji Temple

Tokyo's oldest temple, founded in the 7th century, drawing millions of visitors each year for its spiritual atmosphere and traditional architecture.



## 2 雷門 Kaminarimon

As the symbolic entrance to Sensoji Temple, the Kaminarimon Gate is **one of Tokyo's most famous landmarks**. The large red lantern hanging at its center is a popular photo spot for tourists, while the gate itself represents the rich history and cultural significance of Asakusa.
